- Council update

- Strong schools critical to the health of our communities

Achievement 2015

New national test landscape

- GCSEs 55% 'good' GCSEs inc En and Maths- down 1%
- KS2 84% combined reading /writing/ maths- up 1%
- Phonics 82%- up 3%
- EYFS 63% good level of development – up 7%



Tests 2016

- New GCSEs 2017- current y10s
- Current y11s- do not take eye off ball- 'old' regime, but 'will count for coasting
- For 2016 new KS1 and 2 tests: draft now available
- KS1: reading; spelling, grammar and handwriting; maths; all formal tests
- KS2: GPS ; maths no calculator; reading- no theme; science writing
- Very different format for current y2 and current y6
- 2016 will count as third year for 'coasting'.



Ofsted outcomes

- 91% good and better overall
- 34% outstanding overall
- Primaries: 87% good and outstanding
- 100% secondary schools
- 100% special schools
- 100% nurseries
